PROGRAM DESCRIPTION OORGC is a 7-month technical course in which the student is exposed to

comprehensive ophthalmic surgeries; covering ocular trauma surgery, vitreoretinal surgery, anterior segment surgeries (ocular surface, refractive surgery, cataract & keratoplasties), glaucoma surgeries, strabismus surgeries, & oculoplasty & orbit surgeries, in dedicated & highly specialized operating rooms (ORs). Students will have 1-month rounds in the six ORs of the center. The student is interactively mentored by at least one subspecialist faculty surgeon & be instructed by at least one experienced ophthalmic operating

room nurse during the course & in each OR.

He/ She will develop advanced skills & orientation over ophthalmic surgical routines (as scrub and circular nurses), devices & maintenance issues.
